

Dr Edwards and Bishop King's Fulham Charity

Volunteer Trustees

Dr Edwards and Bishop King's (DEBK) is a local grant giving charity. We allocate over 400K per year to people in need, within our locality (Fulham) – some of this going to individuals, some going to support groups, and some to help pay for summer play schemes. The guidelines on who we can give support to are set out in a Deed of Trust, but decisions within those guidelines are made by our board of Trustees. Being a Trustee of this charity puts people in a position to make choices which help shape our community, and we currently have opportunities for new people to join us, in this capacity. **The Charity is looking to recruit Volunteer Trustees.**

We are not looking for people with specific skill sets. Primarily, we would be interested in talking to people who have local knowledge – either through work, or through residence – and who understand the nature and weight of local poverty. Beyond that, all kinds of skills will be relevant and we do have more than one vacancy. So the first stage might just be to talk to us, and find out more.
